Sub : Recommendations of the Consent Committee – reg.

Ref : Proceedings of the 65th Consent Committee held on 10.12.2015

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In the 65th Consent Committee held on 10.12.2015, the committee after detailed discussion resolved on certain issues related to consent/authorization. Accordingly, the same are listed below to take action by the respective Section Heads and Regional Officers. The action taken on the same will be reviewed in the ensuing Consent Committee Meeting.

1. Once committees' resolution on the CFE/CFO/AUTHORIZATION application discussed and decision taken, the same shall be implemented at the earliest without any delay.
2. The Consent Committee Meeting agenda shall be placed for discussion and decision **only after** obtaining all information from the industry, regional office, serving notice & getting reply etc., within time. Once the resolution of the committee is received, calling for additional information for processing of file shall not be made unless the resolution calls for.
3. The 17 category application and the sectors which requires installation of online monitoring system shall be disposed as follows :
 - a. To **refuse** the applications if the orders are not placed for online monitoring system.
 - b. To **return** the consent application if the industry has placed orders and shown the proof of invoice but not yet installed the online monitoring system.
 - c. To process the application if the online monitoring system is installed and connected to CPCB server.
4. Application seeking Registration for authorization for Import & Export of Hazardous Waste shall be dealt according to HW (M H & TM) Rules at the concerned section only. Placing the subject before Consent Committee Meeting is not required.
5. The Hazardous Waste applications which are pending for import permission shall be disposed off by the HWM section within one week by writing to MoEF.

6. The E-Waste applications which are pending for Passbook shall be refused after giving 15 days final directions to resubmit the application with EC.
7. The applications of Infrastructure projects without EC shall be returned by SEO-Infrastructure with directions to resubmit the application with EC.
8. The details of application disposal shall be updated in consent module from the concerned sections time to time to keep track of pendency. All consents shall be dispatched from Help Desk only.
9. The CFO application & HWM application shall be submitted together by the industries at Help Desk.
10. For applications attracting SAKALA shall be attended on priority. A sticker indicating "SAKALA and date of disposal" shall be pasted on the applications by the RO's and on the file by the concerned section while submitting for disposal of application.

All the Senior Environmental Officers at Head Office & Regional Officers are instructed to strictly adhere to the points mentioned above.
