NOTIFICATION

Sub : Prescribing Consent validity period for Large/Medium/Small/Micro –
Red/Orange/Green industries/organizations – reg.

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The Board in its 203rd Meeting held on 04.04.2016 discussed the implementation of CPCB directions vide ref (1), regarding harmonization of classification of industrial sectors and revision of consent validity period for Consent to Operate in respect of large/medium/small Red, Orange, Green & White category of industries/activities/organizations and resolved to adopt the CPCB categorization and also resolved to grant consent to operate under the Water Act and Air Act, with validity of three years for red category large and medium scale industries. Accordingly, notification was issued vide reference (3).

The issue of consent validity period was again discussed in 204th Board Meeting held on 21.05.2016 and resolved to extend the consent validity period from three years to five years for red category industries (large and Medium) with effect from 1st June 2016, duly keeping in view the Business Reform Action Plan, 2016 under Ease of Doing Business initiatives. Further, in the review meeting conducted by Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Forest, Ecology and Environment, Govt. of Karnataka on 24.05.2016, it is directed to review the three years validity period fixed for Red Category industries and to comply with action plan in EODB i.e, minimum of 5 years consent validity be considered.

Now therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 25 of the Water (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and in accordance with the resolution of the Board mentioned above, it is notified that;

- 1) The consent validity period for large/medium/small/micro Red, Orange, Green category industrial sectors/organizations/activities are as under, and this shall come in to effect from 1st June 2016.

- 2) The consent fee payable under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 shall be collected as per the Gazette of Karnataka Notification No. FEE 115 ENV 95(P), dated: 19.2.1998 read with Rule 32 of the Karnataka State Board for Prevention and Control of Water Pollution (Procedure for Transaction of Business) and the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1976 and under Rule 20 of Karnataka Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983.
- 3) The Consent to Operate for Red category industrial sectors/organizations/activities, the validity starting from 01.07.2016 shall be issued for 5 years by collecting requisite consent fees as indicated in the above table under the Water Act and the Air Act respectively.
- 4) The excess consent fee paid by industries earlier if any, shall be returned to the industries by the Board and it shall not be adjusted for further period.

This notification is in supersession of all other orders in respect of consent validity period issued earlier and shall be valid until further orders.
