OFFICE MEMORANDUM

The Karnataka State Pollution Control Board has a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) to advise the Board in matters in which there are none or insufficient expertise within the Board. However in recent past several matters have been referred to the TAC in a routine fashion rising the question such as what matters need to be really referred and as to what procedure need to be followed to refer such matters.

Therefore the following.

ORDER

The procedure to be followed to refer subjects/matters shall be as follows:-

- 1) The concerned Senior Environmental Officer by reasons to be recorded on file shall propose that a subject/matter be referred to Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and shall send the file to the concerned Chief Environmental Officer for approval.
- 2) The concerned Chief Environmental Officer after going through the file noting, if convinced that such a reference to TAC is required, shall approve the proposal.

Subject/matters that may be referred to the TAC shall be as follows:-

- a) Subjects dealing with new process and technologies.
- b) Complex processes including emissions and effluents.
- c) Matters for imposing stringent standards or for evolving new standards.
- d) Technical scrutiny of treatment options.
- e) For other specific advise required for which no expertise is available in the Board.
- f) Any other technical subject on which specific advice is sought.

- g) The section heads shall scrutinize the project proposal and the pollution Control measures and ensure that the information submitted are adequate and pertinent.

The TAC shall be authorized to

- a. To scrutinize the EIA Reports, proposals of pollution control measures/ technologies submitted by industries.
- b. To recommend suitable pollution control measures to be adopted by specific industries/organizations.
- c. To scrutinize of Research and Development proposals on which specific advice is sought.
- d. To recommend the Member Convener to invite any subject experts/specialists to the TAC meeting whenever such subjects are to be discussed. The Chairman of the TAC with reasons to be recorded is authorized to make such recommendations.
- e. To attend to any other task assigned by the Board/Chairman/Member Secretary

It is to be noted that all recommendations of the TAC shall be advisory in nature.
