Sub: - Clarification on interstate transportation of e-waste -reg

In your letter cited under reference , you have sought clarification on the permission required for transportation of e-waste from state to state in this regard it is to be informed that

Rule 16 of the E-waste management Rules, 2011 reads -in case of transportation of e-waste for dismantling or for recycling in a state other than the state where the waste is generated or collected , the transporter shall give prior information to the State Pollution Control Board concerned and the state pollution control Boards of the state in transit.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climatic change has notified the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 in supersession of the E-waste management Rules, 2011 Which is in force from 1st October, 2016.Rule 19 reads as under

**"Transportation of e-waste.** -The transportation of e-waste shall be carried out as per the manifest system whereby the transporter shall be required to carry a document (three copies) prepared by the sender, giving the details as per Form-6: Provided that the transportation of waste generated from manufacturing or recycling destined for final disposal to a treatment, storage and disposal facility shall follow the provisions under Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008

Hence, there is no permission from Pollution Control Board is required for transportation of e-Waste from one State to other State in case of materials sent to recycling unit located in other than the State generating the e-waste.
